

Frequently Asked Questions

Who can work on this program?

All youth and adults.

Does the youth need to submit the answers to the requirements when they are done with the activity?

No. The answers should be reviewed by an adult. The application and patch fee are the only things that need to be submitted.

Will there be more than one Activity Patch?

Yes. There are a series of five patches. They run as follows: Joyful Mysteries Patch; Luminous Mysteries Patch; Sorrowful Mysteries Patch; Glorious Mysteries Patch and the Rosary Patch. All patches are still available.

Is this activity considered a religious emblem, and will Cub or Boy Scouts receive their religious knot after completing the form?

No. The activity is considered a religious activity not a religious emblem. Cub and Boy Scouts will not receive a religious knot after completing the form.

THE ROSARY SERIES (Glorious Mysteries)

The Rosary Series has focused on the different Mysteries of the Holy Rosary and How to Pray the Rosary. This is an opportunity for youth and adults alike to learn more about their faith. All youth and adults are eligible to earn the patch. It is not necessary to send the answers to the requirements. Adults can verify the correctness of the answers.

Requirements for 1st - 5th grade (Answer 5 of 10 questions)

1. When do we celebrate the Resurrection?
2. Who discovered the tomb was empty? (John 20)
3. What was she told to do? (Matt 28:5)
4. Who rolled back the stone from the tomb? (Matt 28)
5. Before the Ascension, what did Jesus tell the disciples? (Matt 28)
6. What did He promise the disciples (Matt 28:20)
7. Where is Jesus seated in Heaven?
8. Who is the Immaculate Conception?
9. When do we celebrate the Immaculate Conception?
10. What is Mary's title in Heaven?

Requirements for 6th - 12th grade (Answer 5 of 10 questions)

1. To whom did Jesus first appear after He had risen? (Mark 16:9)
2. What did He say to her? (John 20)
3. What did the disciples see when they looked into the tomb? (John 20)
4. On what road did Jesus first meet the disciples? (Luke 24)
5. How did the Holy Spirit appear to the disciples? (Acts 2)
6. What sacrament confers the gifts of the Holy Spirit?
7. What symbol represents the Holy Spirit?
8. Why do we refer to Mary as our Blessed Mother?
9. What is the Assumption?
10. How was Mary assumed into Heaven?

Requirements for Adults (Answer 5 of 10 questions)

1. At the Resurrection, what did the Angel tell Mary Magdalene? (Matt 28)
2. When Peter looked into the tomb, what did he see? (John 20)
3. In what town was Jesus going to meet the disciples? (Matt 28)
4. How many days did Jesus stay on earth before ascending into Heaven? (Acts 1)
5. Why were the crowds astounded after the disciples had received the Holy Spirit? (Acts 2)
6. What do we celebrate on the Feast of the Pentecost?
7. When Mary was assumed into Heaven, what signs appeared?
8. When do we celebrate the Assumption?
9. What did the twelve stars on the crown worn by the Blessed Mother represent?
10. What prayer does the Blessed Virgin Mary repeatedly ask us to pray daily?
