The Golden AAD Fund is used to support the ministry of our priest chaplains who serve on the Executive Board. Contributions are recognized with a beautiful limited edition medallion suspended on a ribbon worn around the neck, as well as a certificate suitable for framing.



### QUALIFICATIONS

The Golden Ad Altare Dei Award is given to any adult who financially supports, in a significant way, the participation of clergy on the NCCS Executive Board. For each award, a minimum donation of \$2,500 must be made to the NCCS-operated Golden AAD Fund. This fund is managed and controlled by the Executive Committee of the NCCS. The revenue generated by the fund shall be used to support the activities and attendance of clergy at functions of the NCCS Executive Board. The donor may choose to designate a recipient other than self to receive this award. Both the recipient and donor, however, must be at least 21 years of age and of sound moral character. The final decision concerning the above qualifications of both donor and recipient rests exclusively with the Executive Committee of the NCCS.

The Golden Ad Altare Dei Award may be presented locally or at any NCCS meeting at the discretion of the NCCS Executive Committee.
